Word	Definition
Apprenticeship	A combination of on-the-job training with classroom training
Associates Degree	A two year degree that prepares students for a specific career or education
Bachelor's Degree	Degree awarded to students who complete a 4 year college program
Career	A course of events including all work, paid and unpaid, which are completed during a lifetime.
Career pathways	Occupations within one career cluster are organized into pathways with characteristics they have in common
Certificate	Awarded to students who complete short-term educational programs leading to employment.
Community education	Informal educational experiences that addresses an identified learning need - knowledge and skills.
Community organization	A group of people with shared interests and vision who work together to address common issues.
Entry level Job	A job with little skill or knowledge, sometimes with potential advancement as more skills and knowledge are acquired
Interests	Something that concerns, involves or draws the attention of the person.
Knowledge	Skills, experience, and expertise with a particular area of study
Maine food system	Policy, research, production, processing, commerce, nutrition, and food security and safety are integral and interrelated.
Master's Degree	Advanced two year program of study after a bachelor's degree
Mentor	An experienced and trusted advisor
Occupation	A group of jobs with similar tasks
Skill	A developed talent or ability through training and practice
Transferable skill	Mastery of a skill that can be used in a variety of occupations
